The Home and Community Care Registered Nurse will play a vital role in the overall health and wellness of the Wagmatcook community. Reporting directly to the Wagmatcook Health Director, this position will work closely with residents to provide timely and correct healthcare. This role may be one (1) full-time position, or it may be split into two (2) part-time positions.

Responsibilities:

- Promote Client and Family-centred care.
- Advocate for clients.
- Maintain privacy and confidentiality.
- Complete home visits.
- Attend to clients that visit the clinic.
- Other duties as required.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Must hold a current and valid Registered Nurse license with the Nova Scotia College of Nurses.
- Minimum of five (5) years acute care or home care nursing experience.
- Wound care protocol experience.
- Palliative care experience.
- Certification in Foot Care.
- Case management skills.
- Ability to provide supervision to LPN, CCA and home support workers.
- Competent in use of Electronic Medical Record.
